For Simon and all who were with him were amazed at the catch of fish that they had taken; and so also were James and John sons of Zebedee, who were partners with Simon.

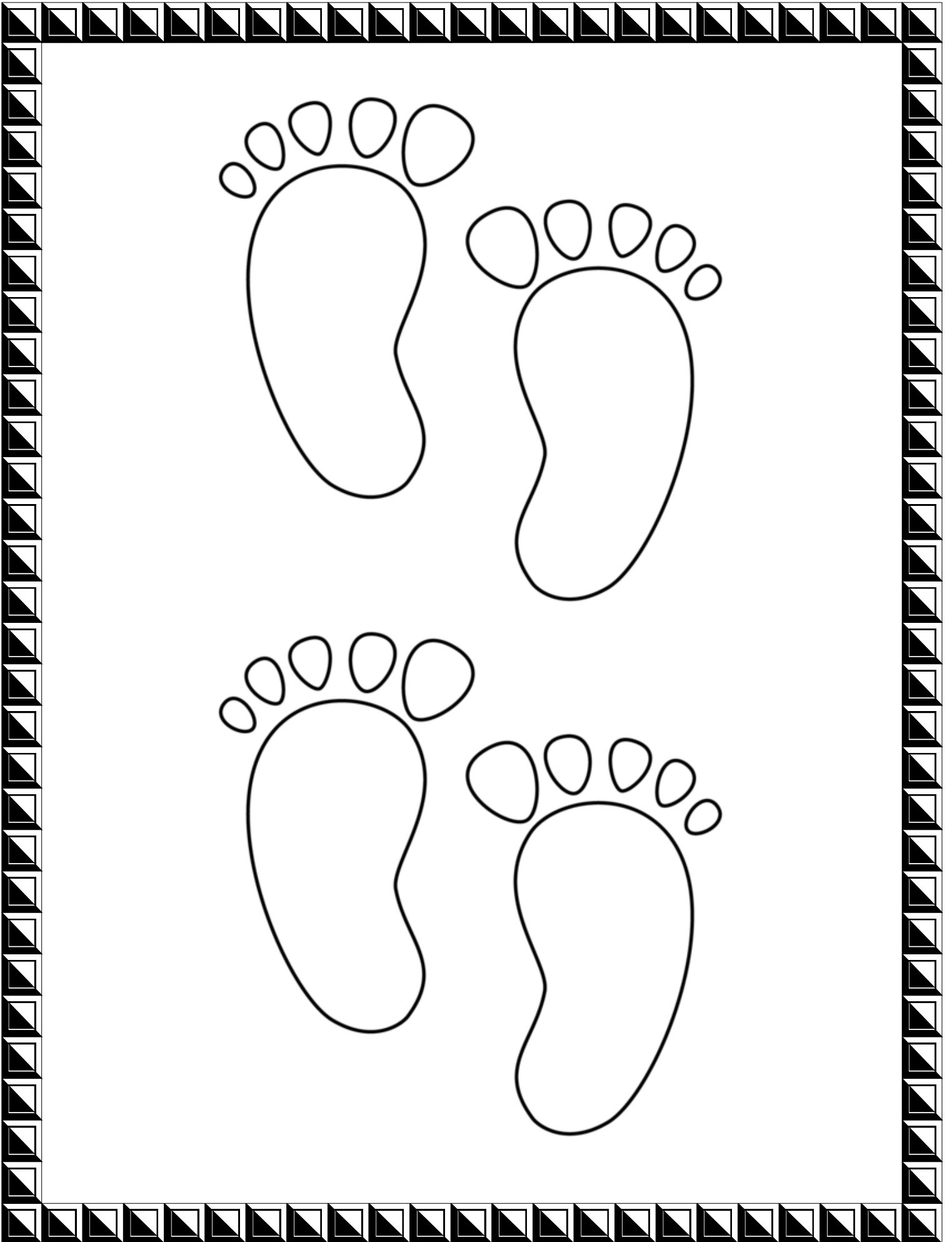

Look around your community. What things do you see that need to be changed? How do you think these things can be changed?


Here are some ways that might get you started.

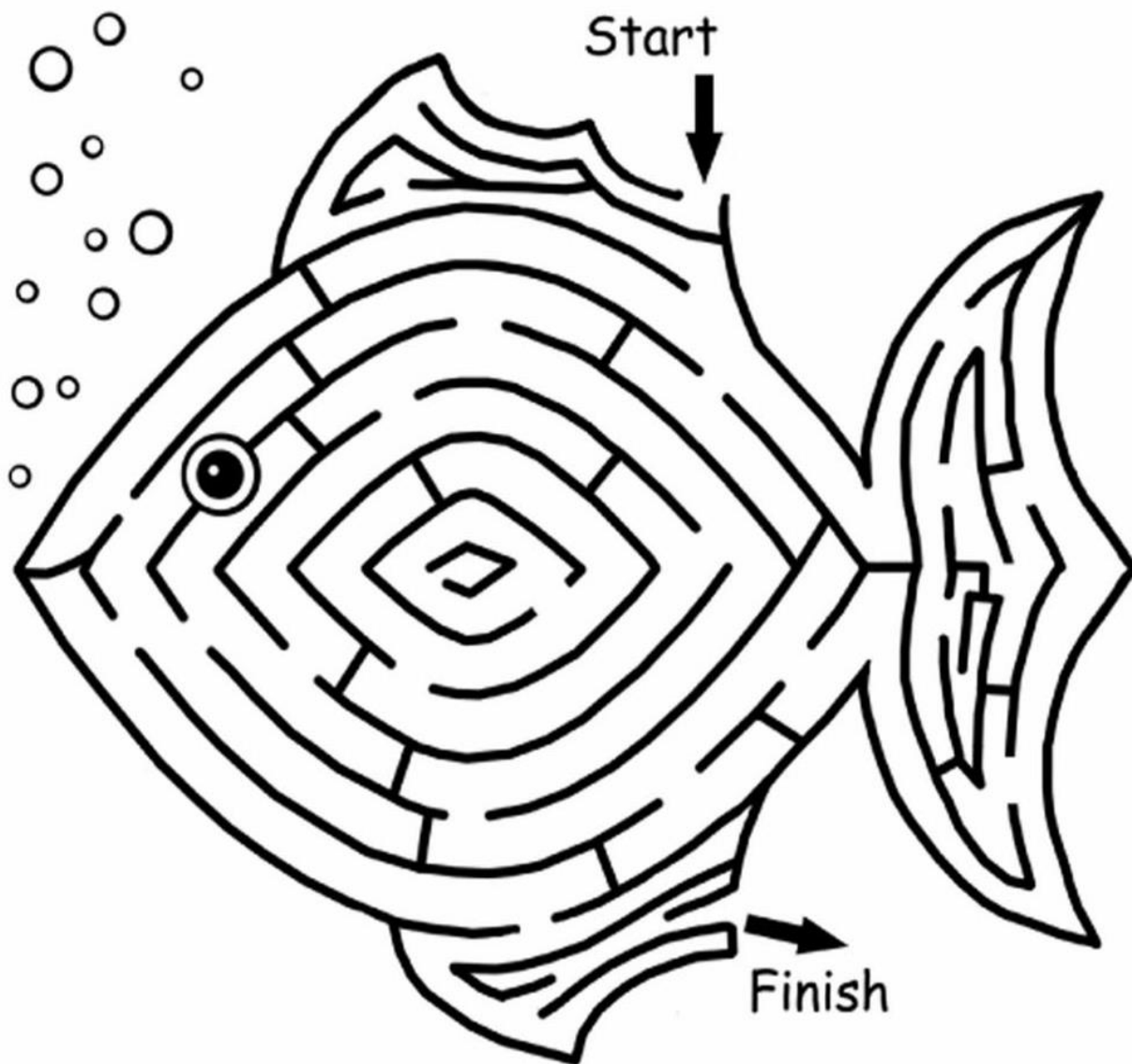

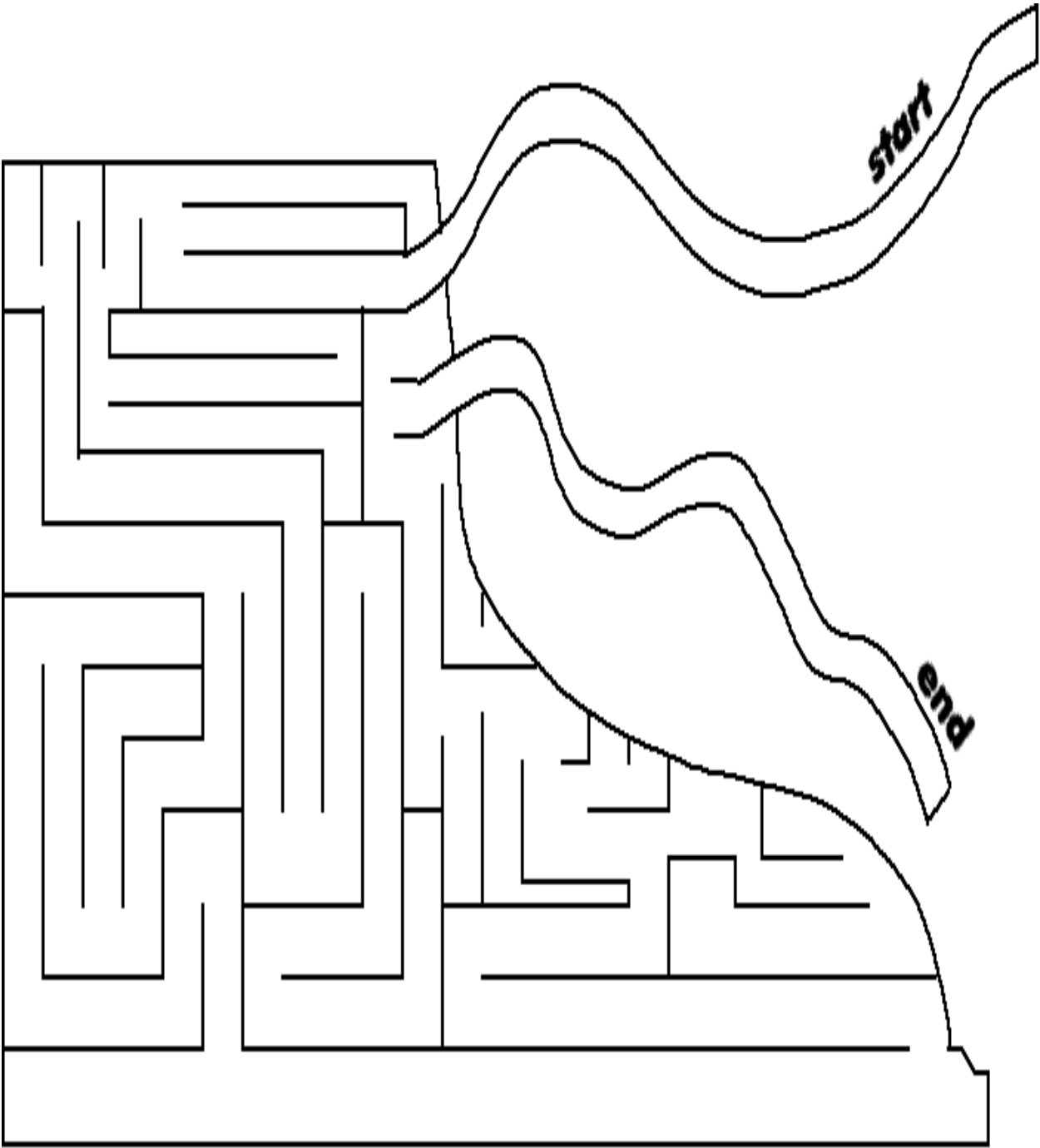

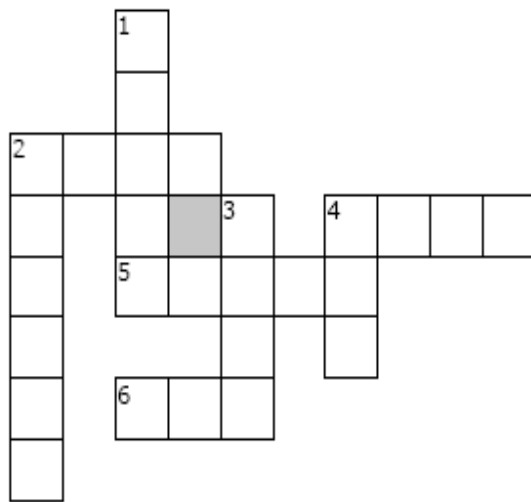
Giant Steps to Change the World Maze

This puzzle is based on Luke 5:1-11 (NLT)



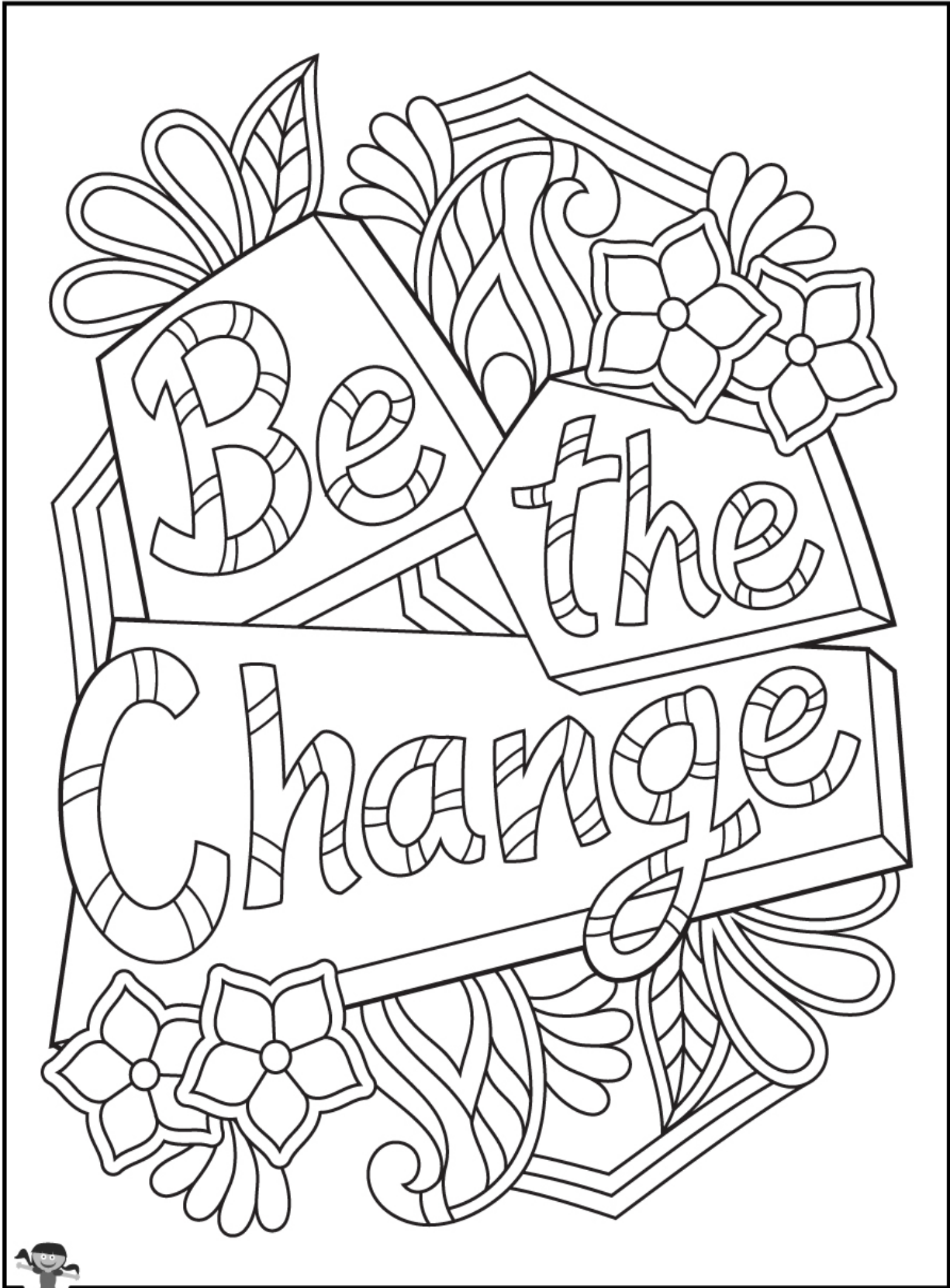
ACROSS
